

Title Board Report

The Federal Program Monitoring process was completed and sent to the Department of Instruction on February 16th. This encompassed our Title I, II, and IV programs, English Learners, Foster Care, and Homeless. I have not received any feedback from DPI, on the report, as of yet.

Another monitoring process taking place currently is of our paraprofessionals. The state is checking on schools to ensure they have highly qualified, certified paraprofessionals. Warwick has been working on getting all paraprofessionals certified. I believe there is just one staff member left to become certified with a Paraprofessional Certificate of Completion.

The status for Title I funding for the upcoming year has been determined. A district must have a minimum of 2% poverty and ten or more weighted units to be eligible. The formula for determining allocation comes from the census count, foster child count, and free and reduced meals count. Warwick's weighted units for 2018-19 decreased a bit, so we may see a slight decrease in our allocation. It will depend on the state allocation amount. It should not be much decrease if any.

The Leadership Team continues to meet and prepare for the Engagement Review in April, 2018. I continue to work on the AdvancED/ASSIST website entering the data and documentation that go along with the School Quality Factors Diagnostics as determined through staff and leadership input. I will continue to build the eProve workspace with documentation needed for the upcoming visit as well.

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
