## WHAT IS A FLEXIBLE LEARNING DAY?

This day refers to a school day where instead of coming to a school, teachers and students communicate online or set up prior learning expectations, and the students continue their learning from home. On an FLD, teachers will share assignments and hold office hours in which they are available to provide learning support to students. Teachers can opt to do this from off-campus or their classroom.

## ABOUT OSAKIS FLEXIBLE LEARNING DAYS

### Announcing and facilitating Flex Learning Days

- Families of students will receive an automated phone call notifying them of the impending FLD, along with our typical announcements on inclement weather days.
- Teachers will communicate assignments for the students in the courses that would have met that day.
- Teachers will be online and accessible during regular school hours to provide support for student learning.
- Teachers may also have sent home pre-planned activities to be used on an FLD. This will be common in grades K-6 but may take place in other grades also.
- As always, accommodations will be made for students with special needs and for students that do not have access to the internet.
