# TENTATIVE AGREEMENT 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR

This agreement is entered into by and between the Cottonwood Union School District (District) and the Cottonwood Teachers' Association CTA/NEA (Association). The Association and the District tentatively agree as follows.

- 1. Compensation: (retroactive to July 1, 2015) 3% on the Salary Schedule
- 2. Teachers will be paid a rate of \$35/hour for teaching summer school.

  Teachers will be paid a rate of \$35/hour for any Professional. Development/Training Days which have been preapproved by the Superintendent. Classes that are taken for advancement on the salary schedule are not subject to daily rate or extra compensation by the District.

  Teachers will be paid their daily rate for the planning days.
- 3. This agreement is subject to the final approval of the Board of Trustees of the District, the final approval of the members of the Association and the final approval of the Shasta County Office of Education.
- 4. The District representatives shall recommend approval of this agreement to the Board of Trustees. The Association representatives shall recommend approval of this agreement to the Association members.
