

Kindergarten Supply List

Dear Parents,

Below is a list of supplies that your child will need for Kindergarten. Please send the supplies with your child on his/her first day of school!

Supplies:

- 1 box of Ticonderoga pencils for the class to share (Ticonderoga's points don't break as easily and they sharpen evenly)
- 2 sturdy cardboard folders with the pockets on the bottom and no middle piece for loose leaf to be attached (Please do not get the very slippery plastic ones, everything slides right out!)
- 2 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons (not larger than that)
- 4-6 glue sticks (Elmers and Crayola are the best. Rose Art does not stick)
- 1 pair of blunt-tip child scissors (Fiscars are best)
- 4 thin black Expo dry erase markers (I know they want the cool colors, but then they are all paying attention to what color they have and not working)
- 1 plastic 5"x 8" pencil box to keep on their desk
- 1 backpack big enough to fit a full size folder and their lunch bag if possible
- 1 composition notebook (not the one with the spirals)

Optional, but very helpful:

- 2 boxes of tissues (nothing fancy)
- 1 pack of diaper wipes (nothing fancy)

For home you should also get a small shoe box or container and put a box of crayons, a few sharp pencils, a pair of scissors and a glue stick for doing homework. This is where you can get the 64 count box of crayons and the cute pencils and erasers if your child really wants them. You will not need anything else for home.
