North Park Elementary will provide materials and trainings to help parents work with their children by:

- Encouraging parents to attend SEP's,
- · Providing trainings during annual math and literacy nights, and
- Providing training during an annual Title I parents' night.

North Park Elementary will communicate effectively and reach out to parents by:

- Frequently updating the school website and social media,
- Implementing and coordinating parent programs that build ties between parents and the school, and
- Sending home a weekly newsletter.

North Park Elementary will coordinate with Head Start, district preschool, and other home or public preschool programs to involve parents in the education of their children by:

- Providing Kindergarten "Getting to Know You Days," and
- Providing a Kindergarten Round-Up for Pre-K children.

North Park Elementary will ensure that information related to school programs, meetings, trainings, and activities is sent home in a format and, to the extent feasible, language the parents can understand by:

- Translating key documents and providing translated documents to parents upon request or need, and
- Communicating with parents using the school messenger system and sending printed notes home.
