☐ Check with Head Coach, Graduation Coach, and Athletic Director about NCAA Eligibility if playing in college.

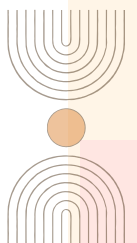
☐ Make sure you are on track to graduate

- ☐ Begin researching financial aid options for potential colleges.

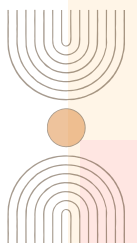

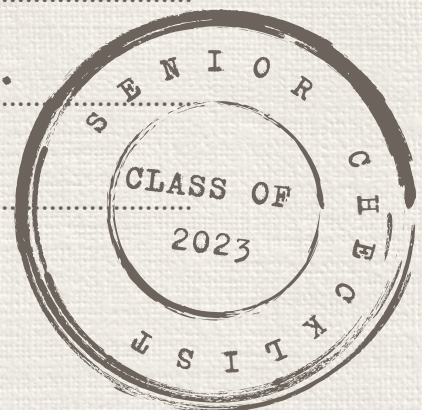




# SENIOR CHECKLIST

## FALL SEMESTER

- ☐ Take a Fall SAT/ACT if needed (have test scores by December)
- ☐ Attend info workshops for schools, military, or potential job sites.
- ☐ Begin building your Resume
- ☐ Build list of colleges to apply to
- ☐ Determine early action deadlines for colleges in the Fall & apply.
- ☐ Create a detailed list comparing colleges.
- ☐ Send transcripts through Parchment for Early Action college applications.
- ☐ FAFSA - Opens October 1st
- ☐ Make a list of scholarships with deadlines and begin applying
- ☐ Job shadow or intern with potential job sites
- ☐ Get some hands-on experience for the field you plan on entering
- ☐ Look at post-high school requirements for your field of interest (certificates, training, etc.)
- ☐ Meet with a recruiter and make a plan for senior year.
- ☐ Check progress for Graduation - are you on track?
- ☐ Ask teachers about Letters of Recommendation if attending college.
