Introductions: Mrs. Capener welcomed the council and excused President Layne Sorensen.

Teacher Proposal: Heidi Jensen proposed a Senior Summer Scholarship program. The workshop would be scheduled for two summer days to help Sterling Scholars and other seniors prepare their digital portfolios. They would also receive individual help in essay writing.

Total Cost - \$750

Facilitator Salaries – 2 Teachers @ \$100 a day - \$400

Supplies - \$350

Budget: Mrs. Capener explained that the state wants our school to keep our carryover at less than 10%. She would like us to try and spend all of the budget for the 2018-19 school year. In order to do that some amendments need to be made to the budget.
