CHROMEBOOK HANDBOOK

- ***Monitoring***

Chromebooks remain property of the Chattahoochee County Schools and all users understand that their use of the Chromebook can and may be strictly monitored electronically or otherwise by School District personnel at any time.

- ***Lost or Damaged Chromebooks***

Student/Parent/Guardian will be held financially responsible for the repair or replacement of the item(s). The student's high school diploma, transcripts, and reports cards will be held until they return their Chromebook or pay replacement fees.

- ***General Precautions***

Student must keep the Chromebook in the padded case provided by the Chattahoochee School District at all time and is handled with care.

- ***Using Your Chromebook At School***

Students must be responsible for bringing their Chromebook to all classes unless specifically advised not to do so by their teacher.

CHROMEBOOK HANDBOOK

- *Using Your Chromebook At Home*

5th grade through 12th grade Students are required to take their Chromebook home each night throughout the school year for charging. Students should charge their Chromebook each evening. If students leave their Chromebook at home, they will have to work with pencil and paper and transfer work to the Chromebook at home. Repeat violations of this policy will result in referral to administration and possible disciplinary action.

- *Using Sound on Your Chromebook*

Sound must be always muted unless permission is obtained from the teacher for instructional purposes. Students may also be instructed to use earbuds or headphones.

- *Printing at School*

Printing functionality will be available on a limited basis at school and subject to classroom requirements. Teaching strategies will facilitate digital copies of homework. If you need to print, ask your teacher.

CHROMEBOOK HANDBOOK

- *Managing Your Files and Saving Your Work*

Students should save all files and documents to their Chattco.org Google Drive. Saving to the Google Drive will allow students access to their files accessible from any computer with internet access logging in with their Chattco.org Google email account.

- *Inspection*

Students may be selected at random to provide their Chromebook for inspection. The purpose for inspection will be to check for proper care and maintenance, as well as inappropriate material being carried into the school.

- *Technical Support*

Students/Parents need to report any technical issues with their Chromebook to their school's Media Center and fill out a technical maintenance form.

- ***Distribution Date and Locations***

- Early distribution will start July 19th for grades 6th-12th between 9AM-4PM Mon-Thursday
 - 6th-12th Grade will pick up at **CCMHS** Media Center (360 GA Hwy 26 Cusseta, Ga 31805)
 - Student/Guardian(s) who complete the process during August 4th CCMHS Open House and/or August 5th **CCEC** Open House will receive their Chromebook on the First Day of School (August 9th, 2021)

- ***Pick-Up Process***

- Students **must** be registered for the upcoming school year before being able to check out a Chromebook.
- Front office staff will direct student(s) / guardian(s) to the building's Media Center.
- Student(s) and Guardian(s) will need to review the Chromebook Usage Handbook located **here**.
- There will be **no** need to print the Sign-Out form as it will already be with a device. Both student(s) and guardian(s) will need to sign the sign-out form.
- Once the \$20 equipment fee is processed a Chromebook from 1:1 inventory will be checked out to your student.
- Students are asked to log into the Chromebook with their **@chattco.org** before leaving the school. Some students may experience a delay in obtaining an Email address.

Chromebook FAQ

- ***What is a Chromebook? Why did we pick this device?***

A Chromebook is like a laptop but is less expensive, lighter, and faster. It generally starts up in less than ten seconds, connects to Internet-based resources quickly, and provides six to eight hours of battery life.

- ***How are the Chromebook devices being funded?***

The district is purchasing the devices. The addition of a \$20 annual student 1:1 device fee from each 5th-12th grade student will help offset a portion of the cost required for maintenance and day-to-day normal wear and tear.

- ***If a family has significant financial hardships, will the student be receiving a discount for the Chromebooks?***

Please contact your students' school's principal for more information and to determine eligibility

- ***Can families opt out of a Chromebook?***

Yes, however, it is recommended that a student have a personal device for academic studies. Without a device, students will be unable to fully participate in classroom activities and assignments.

Chromebook FAQ

- ***Will 1:1 Learning eliminate textbooks and/or associated costs?***

The goal of 1:1 is to assist families and schools in reducing the need for as many supplies. While paper will still be used, the 1:1 program should help in starting to minimize the need for as many copies. Also, 1:1 will allow families more access to review class assignments and such through Google Classroom. Google Classroom can be accessed without the Internet.

- ***What happens if the device is lost, damaged, or stolen?***

While some instances are uncontrollable the district will make the final decision if the loaner party is responsible for repairs and/or replacement. Please refer to the Chromebook Usage Handbook [here](#) for parts cost information.

- ***What type of security will be on the Chromebooks?***

The District uses GoGuardian for reporting and filtering. A no-cost parent app, GoGuardian, that can be found on the Google Play and Apple Store to assist in parental reporting.
