

## Shelbyville CUSD #4 2021-2022 Back to School Plan – July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021

1. The district will continue to monitor the health of our students and staff and adjust the Back to School Plan accordingly if needed after consultation with the Shelby County Health Department.
2. Return to full day in-person learning.
3. School will be in session from 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM on regular days of attendance.
4. Face Coverings are recommended (per CDC, IDPH, ISBE on July 9/10), but not required. Any future guidance from CDC, IDPH, ISBE will be considered.
5. Remote learning will follow ISBE's guidelines (only for students that must quarantine and not eligible for a vaccine).
6. Temperature checks and symptom screening will be discontinued. Parents should keep their children home from school if they are sick or exhibiting COVID-19 related symptoms.
7. The school district will work with the Shelby County Health Department regarding possible quarantining of students and staff; and potential close contacts.
8. Students with COVID-19 symptoms at school will be able (with signed parent permission form) to be administered a rapid COVID-19 test by a school district nurse. If the test is negative, the student may remain at school. If the student is positive, the student will be required to quarantine per IDPH/Shelby County Health Department procedures. Students with COVID-19 symptoms that do not utilize the rapid COVID-19 test, will be required to follow the most current IDPH/Shelby County Health Department return to school procedures.
9. Good hand hygiene will be strongly encouraged at all grade levels.
10. Social distancing will be maintained to the greatest extent feasible.
11. Buildings and school buses will be cleaned each evening.
12. All students will receive free breakfast and lunch per USDA. At this time, weekend meals will also be available.
13. Athletic programs will run as normal with full activity fees charged and admissions.
14. Field trips and fundraisers will resume as normal.
15. Semester Exams will return for appropriate building or grade levels.
16. Locker rooms will be utilized for physical education.
