Student Attendance

Regular attendance is necessary for your child's success. It is necessary for you to call your child's school if she/he is going to be absent or tardy. Absences/Tardiness: A doctor's excuse may be needed for any student absent from school for more than 3 consecutive days.

Elementary students are considered tardy if they are not in their classroom after the second bell has rung at 8:05 a.m.

Middle School students should arrive to school by 7:52 a.m. (first bell). Students should be seated in the classroom by 7:55 a.m. (second bell). If a Middle School student arrives to class after the second bell (7:55) has rung, she/he is considered tardy. If a student is more than 10 minutes late to class, she/he will be considered absent from that class.

High School students should arrive to school by 7:50 a.m. (first bell). Class starts at 7:55 a.m. (second bell). If a High School student arrives to class after the second bell (7:55) has rung, she/he is considered tardy. If a student is more than 10 minutes late to class, she/he will be considered absent from that class.
