



LSA Entrance Requirements

Upon registration, parents must provide:

- A transcript from an accredited school or education program showing the successful completion of the prior school year's grade (if applicable including the Constitution Test taken and passed during the 7th or 8th grade year)
- At least one reference form completed by a certified teacher or principal from the last school year
- All financial paperwork including a completed ACH form for tuition payments.

Prior to entry, student must:

- Pass a placement test in both Math and English showing their ability for success in LSA Academics
- 3rd – 12th grades must be proficient in or take a summer course for Google – Classroom, Docs, Slides
- 5th – 12th grades must be proficient in communicating via email and check it daily – this is how LSA communicates
- Be responsible for their own assignments, grades, and behavior daily
- Understand that no outside food or drink is allowed unless it is in their lunchbox
- Agree to the LSA cell phone policy which states grades up to 6th have their phones in the teacher's possession during the school day and 7th – 12th not use cell phones anywhere other than at their lockers during passing periods
- Agree to abide by dress code policies at all times
- Treat all LSA staff and students with respect

Prior to acceptance, parents must:

- Be able to communicate via internet & email – we do not accept phone calls for attendance or appointments – those must be done on our website
- Agree to purchase/provide a Chromebook for student grades 4th – 12th for their time at LSA. No other devices are allowed
- Be able to check grades online – that is how LSA communicates grades
- Have a Google or See Saw account and able to access See Saw or Google Classroom Summaries – this is how LSA communicates assignments/tests/quizzes/tasks
- Understand that while parental guidance is necessary, students are responsible for their assignments, grades, and behavior daily
- Understand that teachers, administrators, and staff are professionals and should be treated as such at all times
- Understand that due to COVID-19, our school does not allow visitors during the school day – parents must make an appointment to come in to school to speak with teachers or principals
- Understand that tuition payments will be drawn out each month from a checking or savings account. Other forms of tuition payments will not be accepted and a \$25 fee applies if a payment is frozen
