What is an "extended year" pay supplement and how is it calculated?

Teachers work on a 190 day contract. When teacher's services are required beyond this number of days during a year such teachers are entitled to additional compensation.

The amount of the supplement is calculated as follows:

- 1. Determine the daily rate of pay:
 - a. Ascertain the annual local plus state compensation for a 190 day year
 - b. Divide this amount by 190
- 2. Multiply the daily rate by the number of days worked during a year beyond a standard 190 day year
- 3. The product is the extended year supplement for the year
