

Alexander Special School Board Meeting
Alexander Public School
November 17, 2020
7:00 p.m.

Members present: Lashell Tjelde, Darcy Delaney, Cameron Wahlstrom, Chris Cloud, Superintendent Bieber, Principal Faller, Assistant Principal Allard, Business Manager Fixen, Chris Link (via zoom) and stakeholders and staff live presence and virtual.

President Tjelde called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Delaney moved to approve the Agenda, Wahlstrom seconded all voting aye motion passed.

President Tjelde opened with the following: "We are here to discuss the temporary Governor's Executive Order 2020-43 and the State of North Dakota Department of Health 2020-08. This being a mandate means there is a start date and an end date for a short period of time that we need to adhere to while in effect."

Vice President Cameron Wahlstrom read a statement and made a motion that the Alexander Public School District acknowledges and will encourage the following of the North Dakota Department of Health Executive Order 2020-08 along with the Governor's Executive Order 2020-43. With that being said, the Alexander School District is not an enforcement agency of mandates. Therefore, Alexander Public School, including administration and teachers, will not police the use of masks being worn or not worn in the school or in school transportation. Currently, according to the Alexander Public School Policy Handbook, administration can contact the proper enforcement agency if they deem necessary for a violation of law. It then is up to local law enforcement to respond accordingly, Chris Cloud seconded the motion, all voting aye the motion passed.
