

PIONEER PLEASANT VALE COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL ALERT SYSTEM

**BASED ON GARFIELD COUNTY COVID-19 WEEKLY CASE
THRESHOLD**



Due to the ever-changing nature of Covid-19 and the continual flow of new information, the Pioneer Board of Education has issued authority to the administration to make necessary changes and may amend or update this policy frequently. It is recommended that constituents periodically reference this policy for new information or any changes in policy.

LOW

(Fewer than 30 Cases per 100,000)

Masks:

Masks are OPTIONAL for all students and staff

Visitors and Service Providers:

It is recommended that school visitations be limited. Visitors allowed inside campus buildings may be asked to wear masks at all times. Temperature and symptom checks may be required.

Extracurricular Activities and Group Assemblies:

It is recommended that all attendees social distance no less than 3 feet from other guests and sit only with other family members from the same household.

INTERMEDIATE

(More than 30 but fewer than 60 cases per 100,000)

Masks:

Masks may be required where social distancing cannot take place, small classrooms with large classes, school transportation and between class periods. Exceptions are allowed for the following: when eating meals, recess and physical education if social distancing is possible.

Screenings:

Temperatures may be taken of all individuals who enter the building. Anyone with a temperature over 100.0 degrees will be isolated from others and not allowed entry into the main portion of the buildings.

Visitors and Service Providers:

It is recommended that school visitations be restricted and that any visitors allowed inside campus buildings wear masks at all times. Temperature and symptom checks are required.

Extracurricular Activities and Group Assemblies:

It is recommended that all attendees social distance no less than 3 feet from other guests and sit only with other family members from the same household. It is also recommended that masks are worn at inside events or when going to social areas, restrooms and concession stands.

HIGH

(More than 60 cases per 100,000)

Masks:

Depending on latest information available, mask wearing may be REQUIRED for all students and staff in grades 3rd-12th. Areas of concern will be where social distancing cannot take place, small classrooms with large classes, school transportation, between class periods, and route buses. Exceptions are allowed for the following: when eating meals, recess and during physical education, if social distancing is possible.

Screenings:

Temperatures will be taken of all individuals who enter the building. Anyone with a temperature over 100.0 degrees will be isolated from others and not allowed entry into the main portion of the buildings.

Visitors and Service Providers:

It is recommended that school visitations be prohibited and that any service providers allowed inside campus buildings wear masks at all times. Temperature and symptom checks are required.

Extracurricular Activities and Group Assemblies:

It is recommended that schools limit gatherings, assemblies and spectators at indoor and outdoor events to decrease community transmission. It is recommended that all attendees social distance no less than 3 feet from other guests and sit only with other family members from the same household. It is also recommended that masks are worn when going to the social areas, restrooms and concession stands.

SEVERE

(More than 100 cases per 100,000)

Schedule:

District switches to an A/B Alternating Schedule approved by the PPV School Board to allow for superior social distancing throughout the school buildings.

Masks:

Masks are required for all students and staff in grades PreK-12, with exemptions for adults and children who are physically unable to wear them. Exceptions are allowed for the following: when eating meals, recess and during physical education, if social distancing is possible.

Screenings:

Temperatures will be taken of all individuals who enter the building. Anyone with a temperature over 100.0 degrees will be isolated from others and not allowed entry into the main portion of the buildings.

Visitors and Service Providers:

It is recommended that school visitations be prohibited and that any service providers allowed inside campus buildings wear masks at all times. Temperature and symptom checks are required.

Extracurricular Activities and Group Assemblies:

It is recommended that extracurricular activities or group assemblies/performances, if any, not allow any spectators or attendees other than school officials, coaches and trainers present within the stadium/venue during contests or performance. It is also recommended that buildings and campuses not be utilized for public events and gatherings.
