

FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA)

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) affords parents certain rights with respect to their minor children's educational records. They are:

1. the right to inspect and review the student's educational records.
2. the right to request the amendment of the student's otherwise in violation of the student's privacy or other rights.
3. the right to consent to disclosures of personally identifiable information contained in the student's educational records, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent.
4. the right to file with US Department of Education a complaint concerning allege failures by Jefferson R-VII School District to comply with the requirements of FERPA.
5. the right to obtain a copy of the Jefferson R-VII School District's student records policy. You can obtain a copy of the policy from the principal's office in each office in the district.
