FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA)

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) affords parents certain rights with respect to their minor children's educational records. They are:

- 1. the right to inspect and review the student's educational records.
- 2. the right to request the amendment of the student's otherwise in violation of the student's privacy or other rights.
- 3. the right to consent to disclosures of personally identifiable information contained in the student's educational records, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent.
- 4. the right to file with US Department of Education a complaint concerning allege failures by Jefferson R-VII School District to comply with the requirements of FERPA.
- 5. the right to obtain a copy of the Jefferson R-VII School District's student records policy. You can obtain a copy of the policy from the principal's office in each office in the district.
