Job Summary:

A professional staff member who prepares and serves attractive and nutritious meals to students in an atmosphere of efficiency, cleanliness and friendliness.

Summary of essential job function:

1. Assist in the preparation and serving of food in a quick and pleasant manner.
2. Assist in maintaining a cost effective school food service program.
3. Responsible for ensuring that during meal services, the supply of food offered is replenished regularly.
4. Assist in the daily cleaning of the kitchen and serving areas.
5. Perform major cleaning of equipment and storerooms at regularly scheduled intervals as designed by the Food Service Head Cook.
6. Maintain a professional cordial attitude with all building and kitchen staff.
7. Follow all guidelines given by CDE.
8. Maintain a clean and presentable appearance while on duty.
9. Performs duties necessary for the safe and efficient operation of the lunchroom.

Qualifications and Experience:

- High School diploma or equivalent required
- 21 years of age minimum.
- Experience in serving a large number of meals at one time.
- Maintain a professional relationship with students, staff and the public.
- Aptitude and competence for assigned responsibilities.
