Top applicants will be selected for an interview with the Altrusa scholarship committee. The interviews will be held **only on Saturday, May 13, 2023**.

1. Application (no substitutions).
2. Your official High School transcript and a copy of any Dual Credit (college) transcript showing your classes, grades, and class rank.
3. Responses to **two** questions under personal statement section.
4. **Two** letters of recommendation (one from someone in your school and one from someone outside your school environment).
5. Your application **must** be signed.

**Do Not include a High School Portfolio or Resume.**

**The application will be disqualified, if:**

1. Your signature does not appear on the last page of the application.
2. Your application is not complete and on official form.
3. You have attached extras sheets. **ABSOLUTELY NO "SEE ATTACHMENT"** unless noted on the application to attach a separate page as needed.
4. A high school portfolio or resume' is included.
5. Any information is intentionally falsified.
6. Your application will be disqualified if you do not include your official transcript or a Dual Credit Transcript if appropriate.

**The following criteria will be considered when making selections:**

1. Application is complete, neat, and organized.
2. GPA (minimum accumulative GPA of 3.0), and applicant's goals.
3. Financial need.
4. Work experience.
5. School involvement.
6. Community involvement.
7. Personal statements.
8. Interview.
