- 6. The amount of the reward is \$650, and will be paid directly to the institution of the recipient's choice during the 2023-2024 school year.
- 7. Applications will be evaluated anonymously. Applicant's name should appear only on the cover page. Names that appear on the letters of recommendation will be obscured before evaluation.

 - 4. Work experience will be given the same consideration as extra-curricular activities.
