Scholarship Application



Purpose: Scholarships funds may be used for degree or certificate education or training at a technical or trade school, two or four-year college or university and a career in a forest resources, business, or a certified pathway which leads to immediate employment with an AOL member company.

AOL Members' families, high school seniors, current college students, or those referred by an AOL Member company who intend to pursue a attend a trade school or a community college are encouraged to apply for the Associated Oregon Loggers, Inc scholarship. Funds may be applied to applicable tuition, fees, books and supplies. Funds are submitted directly to the school, unused funds are to be sent back to AOL.

All applicants must submit:

- ⇒ AOL Scholarship Application Form
- ⇒ Submit an original essay on **“What challenges do you see in the field of logging and what are your views on meeting these challenges?”** not less than one and more than three pages, handwritten or typed (12 point font, standard spacing). *Initial Applicants only not necessary for renewal candidates.*
- ⇒ High school OR GED transcripts (if first entering college)
- ⇒ Letter of Acceptance to Technical Training, 2 year or 4 year or university

The scholarship fund is to provide assistance to students in pursuit a forest operator or resource production related career / area of study. Financial need of the student is NOT a criterion for selection. The selection of the winner will be made by the AOL Scholarship Committee.

Timeline for Scholarships: Application must be received by the AOL Office no later than **April 1** (for Fall entry) or not later than 4 weeks prior to beginning of the start of the approved training program.
