#### Selection:

- The Oregon Small Woodlands Douglas County Chapter Scholarship Committee
  will select recipients. Applicants will be evaluated according to academic
  achievement, participation in school and community service activities, and a
  written personal statement by the applicant, student needs, and letters of
  recommendation.
- The Oregon Small Woodlands Douglas County Chapter Scholarship Committee
  will schedule an interview with the finalists (virtually) for a Saturday in May. In
  the case of an interview, each finalist will be asked to respond to specific
  questions and may be asked to clarify their responses to previously completed
  application form and written statement.

## **Award Notification:**

 The Oregon Small Woodlands Douglas County Chapter Scholarship recipients will be selected no later than May 31, 2023. Notification will occur soon after that date.

#### Amount of the Award:

• There will be one award given of \$750 each for educational cost. "Educational Cost" includes tuition, fees and books.

• A scholarship check in the student's name will be forwarded to the institution prior to the beginning of the fall quarter/semester.
