Dear Cros-Lex Families:

I hope you are enjoying this beautiful summer season! The purpose of this letter is to check in with all of you, regarding our COVID plans for the upcoming school year. The MDHHS emergency orders affecting schools have all been rescinded, and as of last Friday, the Sanilac County Health Department confirmed there are no health orders or directives issued within Sanilac County. This is very encouraging news to share with you! The following guidance to schools for the upcoming school year was shared last Friday by the County Health Department. The vaccination rates in Michigan continue to climb, as nearly 52% of residents have received the first dose of the vaccine. We are hopeful that our number of COVID-19 cases across the state will continue to decline. As of July 14th in Sanilac County, the 7-day average of COVID-19 positive cases and deaths were at 0%. Barring any new regulations, legislative action, or executive orders, all families and staff members will be asked to make the personal choice of wearing a mask to school, or at school events. We will not require the COVID-19 vaccination to work in, or attend Croswell-Lexington Community Schools. Also, we will not inquire on the vaccination status of any individual, student, staff, or visitor. We are still awaiting further guidance from the Sanilac County Health Department on the question of symptom monitoring, our response to positive cases, and quarantining procedures.
