- Without symptoms
 - After day 10 from exposure without a COVID-19 test result, or
 - After day 10 from a positive COVID-19 test result, or
 - After day 7 after receiving a negative test result (test must occur on day 5 or later)
- With symptoms
 - After day 10 from onset of symptoms, if
 - 24 hours fever-free without medication,
 - Symptoms besides loss of taste/smell are improving
 - o If unable to return after day 10, then
 - Monitor daily and return after
 - 24 hours fever-free without medication, and
 - Symptoms besides loss of taste/smell are improving

Communication

- Quarantines/Isolation notifications to DPH as required
- Parent/Guardian notifications for student quarantines/isolations
 - Virtual learning plans/makeup work will be communicated by teachers
