- Remote Learning Overall it seems to be going pretty well. Teachers are pushing out content and are engaging students as best as they can. - Maintenance Grant has been approved. However, comptroller has not released any

 them.
- PTO still have interest in an outside sign. They are willing to put \$10,000 toward the purchase of a digital sign.
- Economic interest forms have been extended to June 1. These forms can now all be submitted electronically.
