1. Provide vision-disabled pupils with special education remediation that will enhance their academic skills and thus enable them to function maximally in the regular classroom.
2. To formulate long-range goals to maintain a meaningful and ever improved continuity for the most effective rehabilitation services.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Demonstrates knowledge of developmental needs of students.
2. Demonstrates effective written oral communication skills.
3. Evidence of ability to establish and maintain effective, cooperative relationships with school personnel, student and parents.
4. Establish on-going communication with teachers and parents.
5. Implement appropriate methods to remediate/control the deficit.
6. Demonstrates understanding and empathy necessary for working with students.
7. Fulfills any other responsibilities as designated by the Director of Special Education.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: 185-working days or as established by the BOCES Board.

EVALUATION: Performance of this job will be evaluated annually in accordance with provisions of the Board's policy on Evaluation of Professional Staff.
