Orientation and Mobility (O&M) Specialist

Provide students with visual impairments or with deaf-blindness the necessary instruction and critical skills to understand their environment and to travel safely, confidently and independently using a set of foundational skills using residual visual, auditory, and other sensory information. Provide O&M assessment and inform the development of individualized, special instruction. Support the IEP team's implementation of skills, accommodations, and modifications to best meet the student's needs.

The O&M requires a Masters degree with specialization - limited contract days, as needed.
