

Motor Aide

Assists students with developing motor skills and related exercises, as directed by the Occupational Therapist. Assists students with physical education activities and utilization of adaptive equipment; and reports to supervisor through progress reports and data collection. Monitor and assist students with activities to develop small muscle and eye-hand coordination. May assist children in learning gross motor skills.

The speech motor aide does not require a degree, high school diploma is needed - 185 days.
