JOB GOAL:

To coordinate the provision of quality early intervention/education services for birth to five special needs children.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Works with early childhood educators in developing and providing integrated programs.
- 2. Assists Child Find Coordinator in identifying 0-5 special needs population.
- 3. Coordinates individualized developmental screening, assessment, and staffings for the 0-5 population.
- 4. Assists communities in developing appropriate early childhood educational options.
- 5. Provides demonstration teacher where appropriate.
- 6. Consults with BOCES and Early Childhood staffs in meeting the needs of disabled 0-5 children.
- 7. Provides information and generates recommendations regarding early childhood program issues to BOCES administration, staff and EC educators.
- 8. Acts as a resource for families of special needs children 0-5, locating and coordinating services available to meet identified needs.
- 9. Develops and implements building level and BOCES wide in-service training sessions for regular and special education teachers in meeting the needs of 0-5 disabled children.
- 10. Acts as a team member in all regards.
- 11. Maintains open communication with all agencies who provide service for identified special need birth to five children.
- 12. Fulfills any other responsibilities as designated by the Director of Special Education.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: 185-working days or as established by the BOCES Board.
