According to the latest 2013 data from the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, suicide is the second leading cause of death for youth and young adults 10-24 years of age.

Lessons will be facilitated by school mental health professionals and delivered by teachers during school hours and will aim to equip students with the tools and resources to access school-based and community mental health professionals for themselves and/or others in need.
