Funded vs. Non-Funded Sports

The following sports are considered “**FUNDED**” sports; Basketball, Volleyball, and Track. The following sports are considered “**NON-FUNDED**” or “**SPONSORED**” sports; Football, Baseball, Softball, and Cross Country.

What does Funded mean?

- The coaching staff receives a salary based on the collective bargaining agreement between the SCEA and the District.
- Officials are paid from the Superior Central General Fund.

What does Non-Funded mean?

- The coaching staff does not receive a salary as the sport is not listed in the collective bargaining agreement between the SCEA and the District.
- Officials are paid from fundraising done by the team.

What is the role of the Sports Boosters?

- The Sports Booster provide support to all athletics at Superior Central. Sports Booster have purchased uniforms, sports specific equipment, and equipment for the weight room.

What does the Advertising Campaign pay for?

- The Advertising Campaign was able to fund all transportation requests from all sports both funded and non-funded for the 2017-18 school year.

Athletic Director Responsibilities for ALL SPORTS FUNDED & NON FUNDED

- The Athletic Director will schedule the games, officials, and transportation (upon request).

Chain of Command
