You must receive and accept an email invitation before you can receive email summaries. Teachers, administrators and your student can send these invitations.






QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR CHILD ABOUT THEIR READING

- » Discuss what your child already knows about the subject.
- Have them explain whether or not text makes sense; this is called "monitoring understanding".
- Encourage re-reading to help clarify understanding.
- Have them write down questions or ask them aloud during reading.











MATH MODELS




