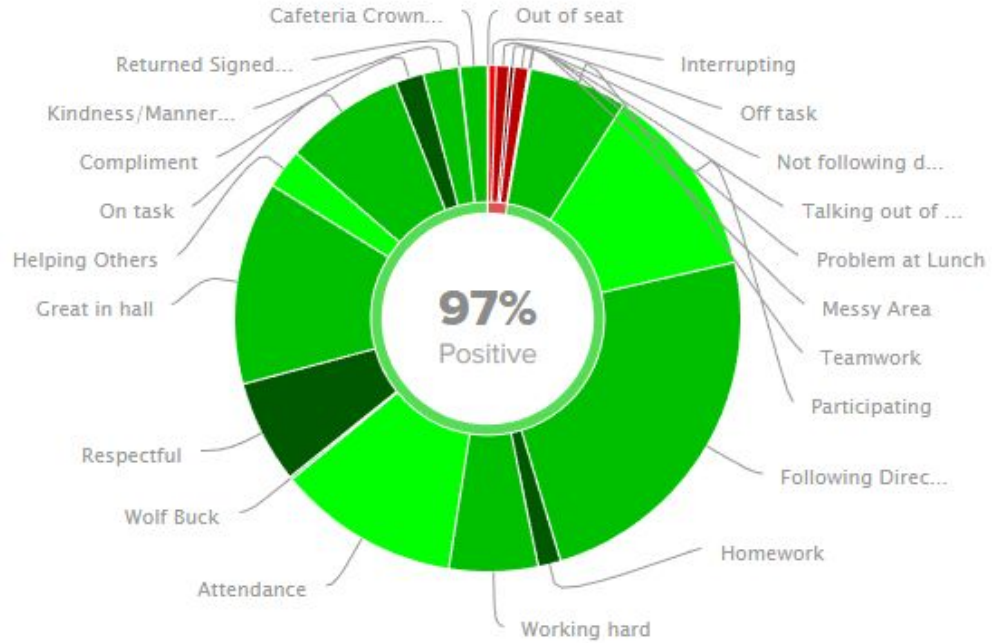

# ***GOOGLE GUARDIAN***

Email summaries

You can choose the frequency of the emails—daily or weekly

Guardian email summaries include:

- × **Missing work**—Work that's late at the time the email was sent
- × **Upcoming work**—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or work that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails)
- × **Class activity**—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers

You must receive and accept an email invitation before you can receive email summaries. Teachers, administrators and your student can send these invitations.

## ***QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR CHILD ABOUT THEIR READING***

- × Discuss what your child already knows about the subject.
- × Have them explain whether or not text makes sense; this is called “monitoring understanding”.
- × Encourage re-reading to help clarify understanding.
- × Have them write down questions or ask them aloud during reading.



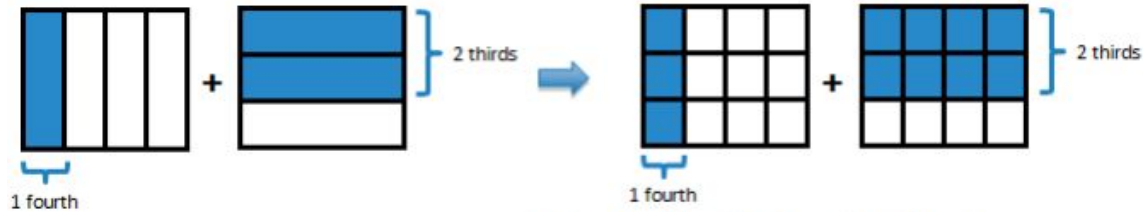

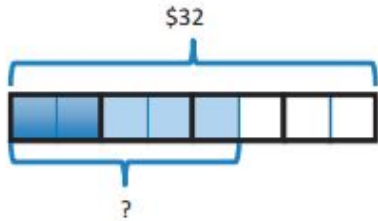
# MATH MODELS

## Rectangular Fraction Model



$$\frac{1}{4} + \frac{2}{3} = \left(\frac{1 \times 3}{4 \times 3}\right) + \left(\frac{2 \times 4}{3 \times 4}\right) = \frac{3}{12} + \frac{8}{12} = \frac{11}{12}$$

## Tape Diagram



Solution with units:

$$8 \text{ units} = \$32$$

$$1 \text{ unit} = \$4$$

$$5 \text{ units} = \$20$$
