
QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR CHILD ABOUT THEIR READING

- » Discuss what your child already knows about the subject.
- * Have them explain whether or not text makes sense; this is called "monitoring understanding".
- Encourage re-reading to help clarify understanding.
- Have them write down questions or ask them aloud during reading.


HOW YOU CAN HELP YOUR CHILD IN SOCIAL STUDIES


