

Free Meals for **ALL ENROLLED** Students At Jones County School District

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For School Year 2021-2022 all ENROLLED students, grades K-12, of Jones County School District will receive free meals. This is due to the district electing a USDA waiver to extend the Seamless Summer Option meal program. The district will be able to operate this program for the entire school year. This means that all students will receive a free breakfast and/or lunch if they elect to eat each day.

Any extras, a la carte items and 2nd meals will still have normal charges if the student takes those items. The district will update the meal accounts for all students to reflect free meals as of the the start of the School Year.

We encourage you, if you have not already done so, to complete the Household Free/Reduced Meal Application. This waiver does not affect meal status and the district will continue to accept free and reduced meal applications, as these applications help our District receive certain funding and the benefits for the families do carry over for the first 30 days of the new school year in 2022-2023.
