_____ I understand when I enroll my student in the MPSDL-A program it is for a semester at a time. If my student is failing the MPSDL-A class, they will receive the failing grade and will need to return to inseat learning the following semester;

_____ I understand if my student has been enrolled in distance learning prior to this enrollment and didn't meet requirements, make adequate and timely progress, complete the course or maintain a 70% or higher he/she may be denied the opportunity to be enrolled in the MPSDL-A program;

_____ I understand if MPS provides a device or wifi access for my student enrolling in the MPSDL-A program, I will sign all technology documents related to use of a MPS device and abide by those documents;

_____ I understand if I check out a MPS device it is to be returned at the end of my students enrollment period in the MPSDL-A program;

_____ I understand that MPS is not required to provide a supervised location for student taking a MPSDL-A course to work on their course during the school day;

_____ I understand that all MPSDL-A students follow the same school calendar as in-seat courses. Students enrolled in MPSDL-A courses are expected to complete all course requirements by the end of the semester as stated on the MPS Board of Education approved calendar;

_____ I understand that all classes will receive a letter grade, but they will not count towards class rank (cum laude system);

_____ I understand that students who enroll in the MPSDL-A program are expected to actively participate in those courses with the goal of completing the course. If a student does not actively participate in a course or is not successful in the course, the district may remove the student from the program and deny the student enrollment in the MPSDL-A program in the future;

_____ I understand that MPS will monitor my student's progress on a consistent basis and advise if the student is not meeting the academic standards for the course and will notify the parent that their student will no longer be eligible for the MPSDL-A program;

_____ I understand that MPS will gather a school-based (district level if required) team to decide if the requested MPSDL-A placement is the best educational environment for the student;



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I _____ I understand that to be successful in an online course, a student
computer skills, time management skills, persistence, and good written
communication skills;

_____ I understand if my student is approved to enroll in the MPSDL-A program and receives
special education and/or related services, the IEP team must meet to discuss the student's
placement in a district approved MOCAP virtual program rather than MPSDL-A. This action is to
assure IEP requirements are met or if the district is unable to meet the requirements at a
distance for IEP requirements;

_____ I understand, if I have a kindergartener, first grader, second grader, third grader, or fourth
grader that being approved for MPSDL-A is on an "as needed basis", due to the nature of
elementary's curriculum, it is best delivered by teachers in a classroom setting.

_____ I understand that I am responsible for understanding how my educational choices,
including my decision to enroll in the MPSDL-A program, may impact my student's MSHSAA
eligibility.

_____ I understand the classes offered by the MPSDL-A program may be different than the
classes offered on any of the MPS campuses and understand my student will be enrolled full
time based on DESE and MPS's expectation for full-time enrollment based on what is offered in
the MPSDL-A program, not what is offered to MPS inseat learners.

_____ I understand that my counselor will work with me and my student to make sure I
understand the courses my student is taking and that my child is properly enrolled in grade level
required classes.
