Parking and Driving

Driving a car on campus is a privilege, not a right. Students are expected to follow all guidelines for operating and parking a vehicle on school property. Failure to follow the guidelines may result in referral to Administration and/or loss of driving privileges.

1. Only students holding a valid driver's license may drive on the HCS campus.
2. The speed limit on campus is 5 miles per hour. Violation of the speed limit may result in revocation of on-campus driving privileges.
3. Students who drive to school must park in their designated parking areas.
4. Students who drive to school must register their car with HCS.
5. All vehicles are subject to search at any time at the discretion of administration.

PARKING PERMIT: \$15.00 Year

1. Permits must be visible on the rear-view mirror.
2. \$25.00 fines will be given to students who do not park in designated area.
3. Permits may be revoked for the following reasons:
 - a. School discipline issues
 - b. Observed unsafe driving practices
 - c. Disregards parking policies
4. Permits are distributed to senior first and then to juniors.
5. If space permits, 10th graders will also be eligible.
