

PARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT #6
Special Board Meeting
March 25, 2019

The Board of Education of Park County School District No. 6 met on March 25, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. in the Westside Annex Board Room. Jenni Rosencranse called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present: Stefanie Bell, John McCue, Brandi Nelson, Cathy Roes, and Jenni Rosencranse. Trustee Keegan entered shortly thereafter. Administrators present: Ray Schulte, Jeremiah Johnston and Beth Blatt.

Chairman Rosencranse called for approval of the agenda.

On motion by Trustee Nelson, seconded by Trustee Bell and carried, the agenda was approved as submitted.

Trustee Keegan entered the meeting.

Mrs. Rosencranse called for action on the staffing request.

Trustee Bell moved to approve an additional social studies position at Cody High School. Trustee Nelson seconded. Mr. Schulte stated that Cody High School administration are asking to add a social studies position that was cut in 2016. The request was made to reinstate several of the social studies elective courses that were eliminated and allow for flexibility in class offering and class sizes. Adding an additional position brings social studies in line with other CHS core content areas which have five staff members per content area.

The board must approve the addition of any certified positions.

Cody High School principal, Jeremiah Johnston, shared his proposal and reiterated that the additional position would bring social studies staffing back to the proper numbers and that when the opportunity arises, CHS would reduce an elective. Motion carried.

On motion by Mrs. Bell, seconded by Mr. Keegan and carried, the meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
