Special Board Meeting/Work Session
January 3, 2018

The Board of Education of Park County School District No. 6 met on January 3, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. in the Westside Annex Board Room. Chairman Simone called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present: Stefanie Bell, Jenni Rosencranse, Kelly Simone, Tom Keegan, Rebecca George and Scott Weber and William Struemke. Administrators present: Ray Schulte. District Counsel, Scott Kolpitcke was also in attendance.

The Board moved into executive session for the purpose of discussing personnel, to consider or receive any information considered confidential by law, and to discuss other matters posing a threat to the security of public or private property, or a threat to the public's right of access.

The Board convened into regular session at 8:50 p.m.
