

**PARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT #6**  
**Board Meeting**  
**October 23, 2017**

The Board of Education of Park County School District #6 met on October 23, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. in the Westside Annex Board Room. Chairman Simone called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present: Rebecca George, Tom Keegan, Jenni Rosencranse, Kelly Simone, William Struemke and Scott Weber. Absent: Stefanie Bell. Administrators present: Ray Schulte, Jeremiah Johnston and Beth Blatt. Also present were: Josh Hays, Cody High School guidance counselor, School Resource Officer, Rayna Wortham and district counsel, Tracy Copenhaver.

The purpose of the special meeting was to address a request for expulsion of the student named in Docket File 2017-18-01.

Mr. Copenhaver explained that the parents had waived their right to a formal hearing and explained the ensuing meeting procedure.

Mr. Schulte gave an overview of the violation of the policies pertaining to the infraction resulting in the recommendation for expulsion for twelve months.

Testimony of the incident leading up to the recommendation for expulsion was given by Mr. Johnston of the high school administration, along with Mr. Hays and Officer Wortham.

Both parents testified on behalf of the student.

Trustee Bell motioned to move into executive session.

The board moved into executive session at 6:17 p.m.

The regular meeting resumed at 7:05 p.m.

Jenni Rosencranse made a motion to accept Superintendent's Schulte's recommendation and to expel the student named in Docket #2017-18-01 for 12 months for threats of violence which constitutes behavior contrary to the welfare, safety and morals of other students. The expulsion is to be for a period of 12 months from October 11, 2017 with the option to be reinstated after 10 months conditioned upon the student having an opinion from a licensed mental health care provider that he is not a danger to himself or to others and which the opinion must be based upon an observation within 30 days of admission to school and provided that he and his parents agree during the 2018/19 school year to regular random searches for weapons or drugs, not to include drug testing, and that he shall not be permitted to leave campus during school hours without administrative permission. Rebecca George seconded the motion. Motion carried.

On motion by William Struemke and seconded by Tom Keegan, the meeting was adjourned.
