

**PARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT #6**  
**Special Board Meeting/Work Session**  
**February 6, 2018**

The Board of Education of Park County School District No. 6 met on February 6, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. in the Westside Annex Board Room. Chairman Simone called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present: Stefanie Bell, Jenni Rosencranse, Kelly Simone, Tom Keegan, Rebecca George and Scott Weber. William Struemke arrived shortly thereafter. Administrators present: Ray Schulte and Tim Foley. Supervisors present: Mark Cozzens Tom Sarvey and Terry Gardenhire

The Board received a presentation by John Gordnier and Cindy Katz on a Cody Country Chamber of Commerce Revitalization Project.

Terry Gardenhire, Mark Cozzens and Tim Foley made a presentation pertaining to security projects, door locks, lighting and telephone system work.

Mr. Sarvey shared updated information he received from the IRS and the agreement that was offered.

On motion by Jenni Rosencranse, seconded by Rebecca George and carried, the following consent items were approved.

- Permission to Bid Security Projects
- Permission to Bid Door Locks
- Permission to Bid LED Lighting
- Authorized the Board Chair to Accept the IRS Agreement

Trustees discussed Policy CKA – Firearms: Personnel Authorized to Carry, at length, including the community survey and questions and estimated costs associated with Policy CKA.

Regulations associated with Policy CKA were discussed as well.

Mr. Schulte shared regulation GDA-R – Paraeducator Certified Substitute Licensure. Trustees shared they were fine with this regulation.

Mr. Schulte shared deleted Policy IJLA – Complaint Procedure to Challenge Instructional and/or Library Materials as it pertained to the KEC committee review of challenged library material.

The complainant of the contested library book shared her concerns.

Chairwoman of the KEC committee, Dossie Overfield, explained the difficulty the committee had dealing with the library book as the Policy KEC did not cover complaints outside of textbooks and materials used for curriculum.

Trustees shared their thoughts and concerns.

A majority of board members agreed to create an action item at the February 20<sup>th</sup> regular board meeting regarding the contested library book.

On motion by Trustee Keegan, seconded by Trustee George, and carried, the board moved into executive session at 10:45 p.m. for the purpose of discussing personnel.

The regular meeting resumed at 11:04 p.m. and was adjourned.
