

**WEST MONONA COMMUNITY SCHOOL
2021-2022 REGISTRATION**

Registration for ALL West Monona students will be done on-line. Registration will include a required registration fee at all grade levels and additional fees for optional items such as snack milk and activity tickets. On-line registration will open on the parent portal starting August 9th. All students MUST be registered for school by August 20th. If you feel you need assistance in the registration process, please do not hesitate to call any of the school buildings. Starting August 9th, there will be computer access at each building if you prefer to come to one of our offices for on-line registration assistance. Normal office hours are from 8:00am to 12:00pm and from 1:00pm to 4:00pm daily.

MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL COMPUTER DISTRIBUTION

Computers for all 6th through 12th grade students will be distributed on the first day of school.

ORGANIZATION OF BUILDINGS

ELEMENTARY- Pre-kindergarten, Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, & 5th grades

MIDDLE SCHOOL -6th, 7th & 8th grades

HIGH SCHOOL - 9th, 10th, 11th & 12th grades

KINDERGARTEN REQUIREMENTS

All kindergarten children must be 5 years of age by September 15, 2021. Students must bring immunization certificates, dental screening and evidence of their physical, including blood lead testing. Those who have not pre-registered must also bring a copy of their birth certificate.

SCHOOL MEALS POLICY/FEE WAIVER INFORMATION

Breakfast and lunch will be served with meals being prepared at both attendance centers. We will continue to serve good wholesome, nutritional meals with a variety of foods. The school district will be participating in the nationwide waiver issued by USDA to operate the Seamless Summer Option for meals, which means that free meals will be provided to all enrolled children during the 2021-22 school year. Applications for Free and Reduced Price School Meals will still be available in the parent portal and in student offices, as an application may be needed for other benefits such as a waiver of school fees and P-EBT benefits. Those families who are directly certified for free or reduced meals will be notified by mail prior to registration and you will want to return the signed fee waiver that is included with that notification letter if you want to be considered for a waiver of school fees. If your child wants to purchase extra foods (grades 6-12) you will need to provide funds for those items as needed. Snack milk prices are shown below.

ADMISSION PRICES AND PASSES FOR ATHLETIC EVENTS

Admission price for home games and conference events is \$5.00 for everyone with the exception of admission to football games, which is \$6 for everyone.

A student athletic ticket covers admission to all home events except tournament games. Student athletic tickets may be purchased for \$55.00 and Adult athletic tickets are also available for a cost of \$100.00.

West Monona School District residents who are 65 years of age or older are eligible for a free senior citizen pass to athletic events. Requests can be made in the Superintendent's Office at the high school.
