VIRTUAL SCHOOL 2021-2022

1. Any student in grades 4th-12th who meet the criteria are allowed to apply for virtual school between July21-July 27.
2. Virtual School student eligibility includes the following:
 - a. Student must have successfully completed school the previous year with passing grades.
 - b. Student must have demonstrated adequate attendance during the 2020-2021 school year.
 - c. Student must have access to internet connectivity and be supervised by a parent/guardian/adult care-giver during school hours. This will be confirmed through the parent's signed affidavit that may be filed with the Juvenile Court Judges.
 - d. Student must demonstrate independence as a learner and able to manage time without re-direction.
3. Exceptions to the above criteria will only be allowed if the student presents with a medically documented health need requiring an alternative learning environment such as home

The virtual school application will be available on the www.chattco.org website beginning July 21-July27.

The parent and student agree that the virtual school program is a 3rd party instructional party, and the student will have limited access to a Chattahoochee County School teacher for instructional support during the school day.
