Whether you are the expecting mom or dad, please call the **Care Connect team (888-803-0081)** as soon as possible to notify us of your upcoming delivery. The Care Coordinator will ask a few simple questions to help facilitate your delivery plans with your Texas Schools Health Benefits Program (TSHBP).

The pregnancy is covered under the TSHBP; in fact, maternity is 1 of 10 essential health benefits under the Affordable Care Act (ACA).

- ✓ STD Testing
- ✓ Rh Incompatibility Testing
- ✓ Prenatal Vitamins
- ✓ Gestational Diabetes Testing

- ✓ Post-Birth Birth Control
- ✓ Delivery

Once your bundle of joy is here, please contact your district's Benefit Administrator **within 30 days of birth to continue healthcare coverage for your baby.**
