School Calendar 23-24

STAAR Testing

After Easter, our students will begin taking STAAR tests as required by the State. There are numerous changes this year to testing and we were not allowed to provide input. All students will test via computer no matter grade level. Additionally, the reading tests have been modified to include written responses. Also of note: the State has not yet decided what the passing standards are going to be, so we will not be able to provide information to you ahead of time regarding the exams. We also have been told that we may not get official results this summer as the Education Agency must review them to decide what the passing scores should be.

Bond projects

We expect to see dirt moving soon on our bond projects. It's an exciting time and we look forward to the start of the changes. We will update you on time frames once those come into focus. We expect to start at the high school soon and then move to beginning the new Intermediate School project before summer!
