New Waverly Intermediate and Elementary Grading Policy

The minimum number of assignments, projects, and exams required for each grading period is 10 (2 exam grades and 8 daily grades for Intermediate, elementary will be 10 daily grades). The maximum number of grades allowable per six weeks is 15. Daily grades and test grades count the same. They are not weighted differently.

Redo Policy

- 1. Only failing assignments can be redone.
- 2. Maximum of a 70 as the recorded grade on the assignment redone.
- 3. Only one chance to redo an assignment for a grade change.
- 4. Assignments turned in late cannot be redone. (Unless due to an absence).
- 5. Assignment will need to be redone within three days after the graded assignment is returned to the student.
- 6. Daily or test assignments can be redone.

The number of assignments that can be redone is three per subject per six weeks.

Late Work

- 1. Students will receive a 10-point penalty for each day the work is late, with a maximum of 30-point late penalty.
- 2. All work is due by the end of the class period of each individual class. Work will not be accepted after the class period ends without deductions for being late.
