Back-To-School Plan

- **Safety Guidelines:** It is recommended that all unvaccinated CMSFHS students wear a nose/mouth covering, maintain social distance (3 feet separation), and use proper hand hygiene while in the building.
 - Masks are optional for the 2021-2022 school year.
 - Stairwells and hallways will be properly labeled to help maintain social distance during passing periods. The stairway near the parking lot will be the UP stairway and the one next to Mr. Klope's and Eisenhower's classroom will be the DOWN stairway.
 - Students will be provided with hand sanitizer before entering each classroom at the beginning of each period. Students are also encouraged to use proper handwashing techniques when available.
- **Entry Guidelines:** Students will not be admitted into the building until 7:45 a.m.
 - Freshmen and Juniors should enter at the front side door by the parking lot. Sophomores and Seniors should enter at the gym lobby door.
 - Students will report directly to their first hour class once they enter the building.
 - Any student with a fever of 100.4 or higher will be directed to the high school library and kept there until they are picked up or contact a parent to leave the building.
- **Lockers:** Lockers will be assigned during the 2021-2022 school year. Students will not be allowed to carry backpacks to class.
- **Registration and Schedules:** CMSFHS will not have a formal registration week. Students will be allowed to register online the week of August 9. Parents/Guardians will receive a link for online registration. Students will be issued schedules on August 17, the first day of school at the door designated for their class above. Juniors will help Freshmen find homeroom classes as needed.
 - Students will be allowed to make schedule changes until Monday, August 30 at 3:00 p.m.
 - All registration paperwork must be completed by August 16th.
- **Breakfast:** Students will be provided with a grab and go breakfast during Enrichment (7:45 am-8:25 am) in the classroom.
- **Lunch and Dismissal:** Lunch will be open campus and will begin at 12:38 pm. Students will not be admitted back into the building after lunch. Any student who chooses to eat lunch at the high school will be required to eat in a designated classroom and released at 1:18 pm for their 6th Hour class.
 - Any student who is assigned detention will be required to stay at the high school until 1:18 pm.
 - Bus riders will be picked up at the high school at 2:50 pm.
- **Physical Education:** Students will be participating in in-person physical education this year. All students will need to purchase a PE uniform and wear appropriate shoes for physical activities in the gym. The locker rooms will be utilized this school year.

- **2020-2021 Schedule:** The high school schedule will have 7 periods. The daily schedule will be as follows:

 - 3:00 p.m.-Dismissal

- **Remote Learning:** Beginning in August of 2021, students will be required to have an approved COVID Medical Certification Remote Instruction form on file at their school in order to remain on full remote learning status. Only students with an approved form on file will be allowed to participate in full remote learning starting during the 2021-2022 school year. All other students will be expected to attend class in person. This form will not have to be completed for exclusions initiated by school officials. Students required to quarantine by order of the health department or their doctor's advice either due to exposure or diagnosis with COVID-19, will not require this form. A note from the health department or doctor stating the dates of quarantine is sufficient.

- **Semester Exams:** A student who meets one of the following conditions may be exempt from semester exams:
 1. 4.50-5.00 overall and no more than 3 days absent each semester.
 2. 4.00-4.49 overall and no more than 2 days absent each semester.
 3. 3.50-3.99 overall and no more than 1 day absent each semester.
 4. 3.00-3.49 overall and no more than 0 days absent each semester.
 5. Any student having perfect attendance, no tardies, and passing grades in all classes.

High School absences due to a documented local health department quarantine or isolation order will not count when calculating semester exam exemptions.

Tardiness WILL be considered a factor when computing attendance. A student who is tardy to class 4 times per semester WILL be required to take exams in all classes. If a student has failed a nine-week grading period in a course during the first semester, he/she is automatically required to take the semester examination in that course. If a student fails all three report card grades in a course during the first semester, he/she is automatically required to take the second semester examination in that course. Any student who is a persistent discipline problem WILL BE REQUIRED to take an exam in a particular class or classes regardless of their academic standing and attendance. Any student who has been suspended from school during the semester will be required to take all exams. Teachers may require a student to take an exam for grades, behavior, tardiness, etc. Any student with 1 or more unexcused absence WILL TAKE ALL EXAMS. Any student who skips school WILL TAKE ALL EXAMS.
