



# Dress Code

Students shall be dressed and groomed in a manner that is clean, neat, and shall not be disruptive or a safety hazard to themselves or others. eStem schools prohibit any clothing or grooming that, in the administrator's judgment, may reasonably be expected to cause disruption of normal operations.

## Student IDs and Lanyards

- eHS issued IDs must be worn around the neck using a school issued lanyard at all times.
- IDs will be used for attendance, special functions, arrival checkout, and dismissal. **(Not required during summer school)**

## Tops

- Students must wear eStem tops on Fridays or participate in Cash for Casual.
- All eStem t-shirts must be purchased from the school
- All shirts and blouses must have sleeves
- Neither shirts or blouses are allowed to be tied at the base
- Clothing with low-cut necklines are **NOT permitted**
- Clothing that exposes the midriff when arms are raised are **NOT permitted**.
- Clothing that fully exposes the shoulders & neckline are **NOT permitted**.
- Camisoles, spaghetti strapped blouses, tank tops or halter tops are **NOT permitted**.
- Clothing with offensive or suggestive slogans or advertisements is **NOT permitted**.
- Shirts and blouses with holes and torn or patched clothing of any kind are not permitted if the student's skin is visible through the open area.

## Bottoms

- Shorts, skirts, skorts and dresses must be knee-length or longer.
- Slits in skirts or dresses must not go above the knee.
- Dresses and shorts made to cling to the body are **NOT permitted**.
- Baggy clothing and clothes that sag or fall below the waistline are **NOT permitted**.
- Pajama bottoms are **NOT permitted**.
- Bottoms with holes, rips, patches are **NOT permitted**.
- Leggings, jeggings, sweat pants, joggers, or yoga pants are **NOT permitted**.

## Shoes, Headgear, & Hats

- Sandals, slides, crocs, and open toe shoes **ARE permitted**
- Slippers/house shoes, shoes that resemble house shoes or shoes with wheels are **NOT permitted**. Flip flops are **NOT permitted**
- Neither hats, hair bonnets, du-rags, headgear, sunglasses, nor bandanas of any color may be worn inside the building.

The dress code will be strictly enforced. The Director of the school has final authority on all matters relating to the dress code. All students violating the dress code will either be given clothing to change into or instructed to call a parent/guardian for a change of clothes. Students given clothing will be allowed to change back into their original clothes at the end of the day. Students violating the dress code will be issued a detention. Repeated violations of the dress code may result in loss of privileges, Saturday School, in-school or out of school suspension. If a student misses the beginning of class due to dress code violations, he/she will be marked as tardy.
