Re: 2021-2022 COVID-19 Protocols Survey

Greetings Lennox School District Families and Staff,

The start of the 2021-2022 school year is quickly approaching. After successfully navigating through this past school year, I believe we are in a better place, with better information, and actual experience to inform our decisions. As many of you are aware, we changed our COVID-19 guidelines and procedures for summer activities, including our Totally Kids program https://5il.co/sypt. The protocols found within this document were less restrictive than how we operated throughout the 2020-2021 school year. Perhaps the most notable change was the decision to make masking optional. The Totally Kids program has operated successfully with no positive COVID-19 cases reported to date and in my observations, I have not seen anyone make the decision to wear a mask.

In evaluating appropriate protocols for the proposed 2021-2022 COVID-19 guidelines and procedures document, we have taken into account CDC recommendations, recommendations from the American Academy of Pediatrics, active COVID-19 case numbers within our counties, and actual operational observations within our summer programs after loosening restrictions. Below is a survey asking for your input on proposed key protocols that will serve as the guidelines and procedures for the upcoming 2021-2022 school year. The "Return to Learn" committee will utilize this feedback in their final recommendation to the school board.
