As per the specific provisions of Oklahoma Senate Bill 658, the following is mandatory for School Enrollment.

"For school enrollment, a parent or guardian shall provide one of the following:

- 1. Current, up-to-date immunization records; or
- 2. A completed and signed exemption form."

Oklahoma Senate Bill 658 also mandates the following.

- 1. Prohibits school boards for school districts and technology centers (as well as public and private higher education institutions) from:
 - Implementing a mask mandate for students who have not been vaccinated against COVID-19;
 - Requiring a vaccination against COVID-19 as a condition of admittance to or attendance of the school or institution; and
 - Requiring documented proof of COVID-19 vaccination.
- 2. It is allowable for a board of education for a school district or technology center to implement a mandate to wear a mask or "any other medical device" only under the following conditions:
 - The board must first consult with its local county or city-county health department; and
 - The area where the board is located is under a state of emergency declared by the governor; and
 - o The mandate must include its purpose; and
 - The mandate must specifically include what masks or medical device would meet the mandate's requirements; and
 - The board must reconsider the mandate at each regularly scheduled board meeting.
