Painting of Student Parking Spaces 2021-2022

The purpose of allowing students to paint their own parking spot is aimed at improving school pride and camaraderie. Students can “own” a piece of the school. We encourage students to express themselves through positive artwork.

In order to follow all city and district codes, please note the guidelines below that must be followed for the painted parking spaces.

- The prices are as follows: parking permit (required for all drivers on campus) \$20, purchase of your own personal spot additional \$30 (you can paint it or not that's up to you). All available parking spots for student personalization will be NUMBERED.
- NUMBERED spots will be first come first serve with seniors getting first choice.
- If you are not planning on purchasing a NUMBERED parking spot for personalization you can do so by just paying the permit fee. If you did not purchase a numbered spot then you will not be allowed to park in a numbered spot. Periodic checks will be completed in the parking lot.
- Cash will be accepted in the exact amounts only, as there will not be any change box available. Checks should be made payable to Wolfe City High School. Students will receive a receipt at purchase.
- Students must have their designs approved by Friday, August 6th at 3:00pm, paid the fee and submitted the proper paperwork.
- Students that are returning and already have a spot painted can keep that spot by paying the permit fee of **\$20**. However, if a student wants to repaint the spot then they will have to pay **\$30**.
- Parking lot Painting will be taking place on Sunday, August 8th from 1 pm-7pm, on Saturday, August 14th from 8am-3pm, and on Sunday, August 15th from 1pm-5pm.
- Students must present their valid hardship TX driver's license and valid insurance covering the vehicle and student, and submit the student parking form. Drivers permits will not be accepted and students are not allowed by law to drive on campus with a permit if not accompanied by an appropriate adult.
- After the form and documentation have been submitted, students must submit a front picture of the vehicle showing the license plate number and parking tag hanging from the rearview mirror once the Student Parking Permit is issued.
- Students must be present or have an authorized representative provide a handwritten note and student signature allowing a proxy to pick their space.
- Students who are approved for painting a parking space must select an outlined space on the parking lot diagram if one is available. Refunds are not available.
- Any artwork depicting items, symbols, or language that Wolfe City HS administration deems inappropriate will not be allowed.
- WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint is the only type of paint that can be used.
- No Reflective paint
- No Spray paint
- No Fluorescent paint
- Students must keep a 4" unpainted border between the white parking space lines and the paint in their parking spot. (please use blue painters tape)

- You may purchase WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint at retail stores like Sherwin Williams, Lowes, or Home Depot.
- We highly recommend that students prime their space to ensure that the current paint doesn't show through.
- Your design should be clearly drawn on this form and must include the colors you will be using on your parking space.
- On your design sheet, please include your first and last name, email address, and cell phone number where you can be reached. Once your design has been reviewed, you will receive an email letting you know if it is acceptable or if any changes need to be made.
- All designs are due no later than Friday, August 6th at 3:00pm in the Wolfe City HS front office or emailed to Mr. Poe at poes@wcisd.net .
- There will be time to review designs and communicate any changes that need to be made.
- Students may start physically dropping off design requests with Mrs. Guiette in the front office on Tuesday, August 3rd or emailing the completed form and art work to kguiette@wcisd.net or poes@wcisd.net . If you have any questions, please contact the front office at 903-469-2891.

Time Line for design approval and painting

Students may start dropping off design requests on Tuesday, August 3th

All designs, forms, and fees are due no later than Friday, August 6th at 3:00 pm in the Wolfe City HS front office.

Seniors and Juniors will be painting their parking spaces on Sunday, August 8st from 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm, on Saturday, August 14th from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm, and on Sunday, August 15th from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm.

Prohibited:

- a. No offensive language, pictures, or symbols.
 - b. No negative or rude language. (be nice)
 - c. No "gang-style tagging."
 - d. No double entendre's. (double meanings)
 - e. ONLY YOUR NAME. A boyfriend's or girlfriend's name is NOT allowed.
- Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Principal. Disciplinary action may be taken & you may forfeit your right to a parking space and /or to drive on campus.

HAVE FUN –

Remember, purchasing a personal student parking spot is completely optional. There will be parking available for students who do not wish to purchase and decorate a parking spot for the \$20 permit fee. These spots will not have a designated number indicator on the spot.

All painting must be completed on the day of the parking spot painting day

Wolfe City HS Painted Parking Spaces 2021-2022 Reserved Parking Spot Agreement

Juniors and Seniors who have completed the following may participate in the painting of their assigned parking space:

1. Purchase a 2021-2022 Parking Permit (\$20 fee to the school)
2. Purchase a parking spot for the 2021-2022 school year (\$30 fee to the school)
2. Submit a sketch of proposed parking space design and have it approved by Principal.
3. Payment (cash in exact amounts or check made out to Wolfe City High School for a combined \$50 fee).
4. Submitted paperwork for initial Student Parking Permit

Students Code of Conduct and all local laws will be enforced regarding the personalization process. Wording or marks of drugs, drug paraphernalia, slander, slang, racism, gangs, or sexual connotation will lead to punishment and /or criminal action. At any time during the year, the Wolfe City HS administrative team reserves the right to remove the Parking Space Painting privilege during the school year if any of the above occurs.
